

The Berkeley Public Library has partnered with **MediaOnDemand** to make a huge number of eBook and digital audiobook titles available to our patrons. Your valid Berkeley Public Library card allows you to quickly access and download these titles to your Kindle, iPad, Nook, or other device. New titles are being added nearly every day!

Searching

	The Media On Demand catalog allows you to search by title, author, or keyword. The Advanced Search adds the option of finding titles by format, language, publisher, and more.


Your Account

	Just like with the online catalog, you can sign in to your account on MediaOnDemand. Your account is accessible by either the 'Sign in' link in the upper-right corner on MediaOnDemand.org or the 'Account' button in the top page section. You will use your Berkeley Library card number and pin to sign in, the same with the online catalog.

Lending Periods

Once you are signed in, you can click on 'Account' and then 'Settings' to view default lending periods. These can be adjusted, and allow you to specify how long you borrow digital items (up to three weeks for some item types!). Be sure to click 'Save' at the bottom of the page when finished.

File Formats

	eBook and audiobooks are available in a variety of formats. When viewing a title, the Available Formats window appears to the right. If you're unsure of which format you need for your device, please see the compatibility list .

Just like physical books, there are a set number of eBooks and audiobooks available to check out at a time. Available copies are shown to the right when viewing a title. If the title is currently unavailable, the *Borrow* button will be replaced by *Place a Hold*, allowing you to be notified when the title becomes available.

Quick Sampling

	Many eBook titles can be sampled to help you decide whether you want to check out the title or not. The image showing the cover of the book will have a little <i>Sample</i> symbol in the corner of these titles. Clicking it will make the first few pages readable.
